## **Guidance for nominations**

Northop Community Council represents the communities of Northop and Sychdyn villages. Members of Northop Community Council wish to recognise the contribution made by volunteers who help others and thus improve the quality of life for local individuals and/or those in the wider Community Council area. Their voluntary work makes a significant contribution to our well-being.

### **There will be 2 awards for outstanding voluntary service:**

- A Junior Award to a young person aged 16 and under
- A Senior Award to an individual aged over 16

For the coming year, the Junior award will be open to nominations from residents of Sychdyn village and the Senior award will be open to nominations from residents of Northop village. In alternate years, the nominations for the Junior award will be open to residents of Northop village and the Senior award will be open to residents of Sychdyn village.

### **What will be considered?**

Any voluntary action to help others and thus improve the quality of life for local individuals and or the wider community (Northop or Sychdyn) will be considered. Nominees must be residents of the Northop Community Council area.

### **What will not be considered**

Help or assistance provided which is carried out in any kind of paid capacity.

If you are aware of a Young Person (aged 16 and under) / Individual (aged over 16) who has or is making a difference to the local community in Northop or Sychdyn and is deserving of an award, please let us know by completing the attached nomination form by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2018.

Each application will be considered on its own merit and the Community Council's decision will be final.
